The Fairfield 19th Annual Tomato Festival began by celebrating Solano County's leading agricultural heritage. The main venue of the Tomato Festival is Tomato Alley, featuring over 100 varieties of heirloom tomatoes grown by Tenbrink Farms. Along with the many diverse vendors, the Tomato Festival also features live entertainment, children's activities, cooking demonstrations, tomato-eating contests, beer and wine garden, and a food court. This year, we are asking our vendors to play a bigger role in our Tomato Festival by having tomato-related or themed items for sale and display in their booths. There were approximately 30,000 people that attended the Tomato Festival last year and we expect to have the same amount this year.

FOOD VENDOR APPLICATION
PAYMENTS: Payments are accepted in the form of check, money order, or credit careful payment of vendor fees is due and payable with this application. If your check returned with non-sufficient funds, you will be required to pay the full amount (by mosorder, cash or credit card only) including any charges from our bank plus a \$35 handling. Note: The Fairfield Main Street Association belongs to the Solano County District Attorney Office Bad Check Program.
CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS: Cancellations will only be accepted in writing, via main fax, then must be postmarked or received 30 days prior to the event. There is a \$25 fee handling refunds, which will be subtracted from your refund. Please allow 60 days for your refund to be processed.
ACCEPTANCE: Applications will be juried and reviewed prior to decisions made on for vendors. Upon receipt of your application, you will be contacted by phone or e-mail if you selected. In addition, your payment will be processed at that time. You will also be notified your booth location.
DECLINED APPLICATIONS: If you are not selected, your check will be mailed back you with notification.

FURTHER INFORMATION FOR APPLICATIONS: Applications must be compared with all details of food and beverages to be sold. There will be only one vendor selling items (with the exception of water and sodas) to ensure a successful sales experience. booths will be monitored during the events to ensure no duplicate items are being so Incomplete applications will not be accepted and will be returned. The Fairfield Main Str Association reserves the right to decline any application that it believes is inappropriate for Tomato Festival.
