There will be a \$10 registration fee for those entering one recipe and a \$15 fee for contestants entering more than one recipe.

Applications must be received by 5:00 pm. Monday, July 25th. Applications received without the registration fee and recipe(s) will not be accepted. Applications can be picked up at the Fairfield Downtown Association office, 1000 Texas Street, or at any Fairfield-Suisun Raley's store at the camera counter.
