

Veterans Day Parade – Thursday, November 11, 2004 Theme: Freedom Is Not Free!



General Rules and Information

- 1. Entry deadline: October 29, 2004. Any entries received after that date will not have priority line up consideration.
- 2. Entry Fee is \$30. *Payable to the City of Fairfield*. All entries will receive a certificate of participation.
- 3. Assembly area- Webster Street from Kentucky Street toward Utah St. & Travis Blvd. *Except Bands:* Bands *PARK* at Armijo High School. Check in at booth in parking lot and walk down Kentucky St. (about two blocks) to assembly area at Kentucky St. from Webster to Union and line up there.
- **4.** Parade will be traditional, allowing one minute for a salute at the reviewing stand. **Groups performing over one minute will be penalized.**
- 5. No political entries- local current, elected office holders are invited as guests.
- 6. The American Legion Flag Code will apply to all color/ honor guards.
- 7. No entry may enter the parade route more than once.
- 8. Entries of participants involving vehicles or animals must at all times maintain control of such vehicles or animals.
- 9. No one under 6 years of age may appear as an entry unless accompanied by an adult over 18 years of age.
- 10. The reviewing stand will be located at the **right** side of the line up. Entry numbers should be prominently displayed on the right, front of the vehicle or first element in the entry.
- 11. Units with unusual sound or noise must so indicate on the entry form.
- 12. Entries must maintain fifty (50) feet between entries, keeping elements of the entry as close together as possible. Entries must also avoid large gaps between their units and the unit in front of them. Subject to penalty if violated.
- 13. NO THROWING OF OBJECTS OR CANDY FROM ANY ENTRY: SUBJECT TO IMMEDIATE REMOVAL FROM THE LINE UP.
- 14. Bands must play through the entire parade.
- 15. **Remember:** One representative must check in at the check in booth on the morning of the parade before your group lines up to obtain any last minute details or line up changes.


