- Check In: Look for our booth located at the Chamber of Commerce parking lot (1111 Webster St., Fairfield CA 94533). 2.
- 3. Check In & Line up begins at 10:30 a.m. Must be lined Up by 12 Noon Start Time: 12:30 p.m.
- Assembly area Webster Street from Kentucky Street toward Utah St. & Travis Blvd. Except bands: Bands PARK at 4 Armijo High School. Check-in at booth in parking lot and walk down Kentucky St. (about two blocks) to assembly area at Kentucky St. from Webster to Union and line up there.
- Parade is a continuous moving parade. No stopping. Be prepared to salute or perform as you proceed through the 5. reviewing stand. Groups stopping on parade route or at reviewing stand will be penalized.
- No political entries local current, elected office holders are invited as guests. 6
